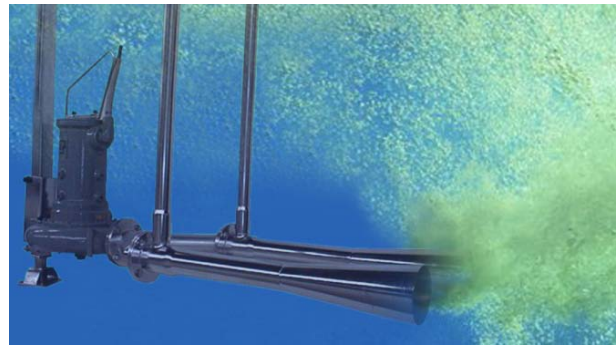

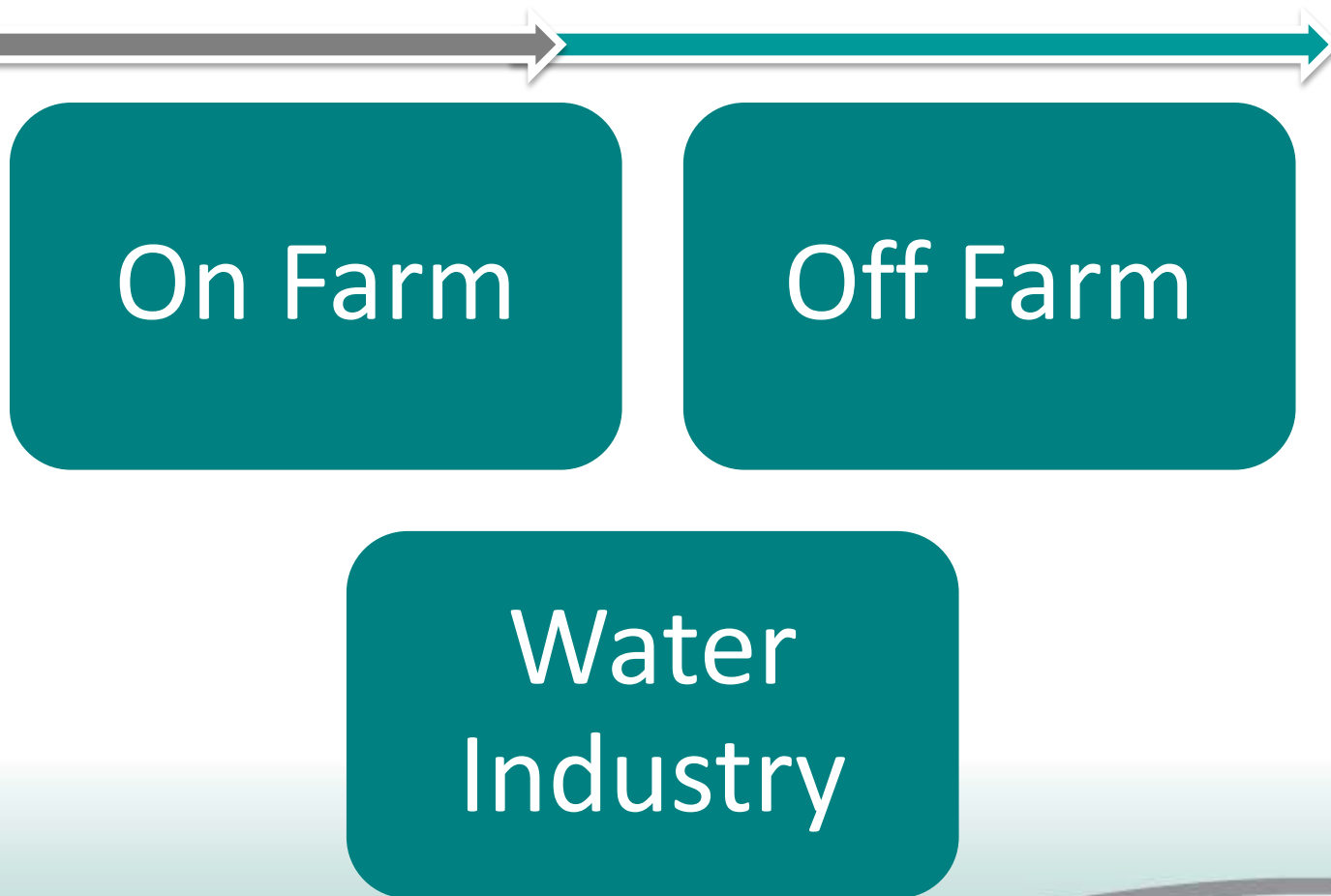


ADBA: a brief synopsis
